

Market Wrap Up

- Key equity benchmarks ended sharply lower today amid broad-based selling pressure. Investors turned cautious ahead of Q2 earnings from Sun Pharmaceutical Industries, Britannia Industries, and Grasim Industries, scheduled for release on Wednesday, 5 November 2025, along with key domestic economic data and global cues. The Nifty ended below the 25,600 level after touching the day's high of 25,787.40 in early trade.
- The S&P BSE Sensex declined 519.34 points or 0.62% to 83,459.15. The Nifty 50 index fell 165.70 points or 0.64% to 25,597.65.
- The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index declined 0.26% and the S&P BSE Small-Cap index shed 0.69%.
- Among the sectoral indices, the Nifty Consumer Durables index (up 0.39%), the Nifty PSU Bank index (down 0.11%) and the Nifty Pharma index (down 0.48%) outperformed the Nifty 50 index.
- Meanwhile, the Nifty Metal index (down 1.44%), the Nifty IT index (down 1.06%) and the Nifty Auto index (down 0.86%) underperformed the Nifty 50 index.

Corporate News

- **State Bank of India**'s Q2 FY26 net profit rose 10% year-on-year to Rs 20,159.7 crore. Net interest income rose 3.3% year-on-year to Rs 42,985 crore from Rs 41,620 crore for the July-September quarter.
- Mahindra & Mahindra reported a rise of 18% year-on-year (y-o-y) in standalone net profit for the quarter ended September 2025. The company's profit after tax rose to Rs 4,521 crore in Q2 FY26 from Rs 3,841 crore in Q2 FY25, the Scorpio SUV maker said. The revenue jumped 21% y-o-y to Rs 35,080 crore in the quarter under review from Rs 28,919 crore in the year-ago quarter.
- Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone Ltd posted a consolidated net profit of Rs 3,120 crore for the July-September quarter of FY26, up 29% year-on-year, driven by higher sales. Revenue from operations grew 30% to Rs 9,167 crore in Q2 FY26.
- Adani Enterprise reported 84% increase in net profit at Rs 3,199 crore for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 on one-time gain of Rs 3,583 crore.
- **Bharat Heavy Electricals** posted net sales at Rs 7,511.80 crore in September 2025 up 14.09% from Rs. 6,584.10 crore in September 2024. Net pofit at Rs. 367.67 crore in September 2025 up 280.34% from Rs. 96.67 crore in September 2024.
- **Bharti Airtel** posted consolidated net sales at Rs 52,145.40 crore in September 2025 up 25.73% from Rs. 41,473.30 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 6,791.70 crore in September 2025 up 89.02% from Rs. 3,593.20 crore in September 2024.
- Coal India posted net sales at Rs 296.09 crore in September 2025 down 6.01% from Rs. 315.02 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 8,342.12 crore in September 2025 up 101.79% from Rs. 4,133.97 crore in September 2024.
- TATA Consumer Products posted consolidated net sales at Rs 4,965.90 crore in September 2025 up 17.83% from Rs. 4,214.45 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 404.46 crore in September 2025 up 10.99% from Rs.

- **Escorts Kubota**'s consolidated net profit declined 1.87% to Rs 318.16 crore in Q2 FY26 as against Rs 324.23 crore posted in Q2 FY25. However, revenue from operations jumped 22.58% year on year (YoY) to Rs 2,791.56 crore in the quarter ended 30 September 2025.
- Hero MotoCorp reported total dispatches of 635,808 motorcycles and scooters in October 2025, down 6.37% from 679,091 units in October 2024. Domestic sales for the period under review aggregated to 604,829 vehicles (down 7.99% YoY), while exports added up to 30,979 vehicles (up 42.83% YoY).
- **Indus Towers**'s promoter **Bharti Airtel** received approval to increase its ownership in the tower infrastructure company.
- Glenmark Pharmaceuticals announced that its subsidiary, Glenmark Pharmaceuticals Inc., USA, is set to launch its 8.4% Sodium Bicarbonate Injection USP, 50 mEq/50 mL (1 mEq/mL) single-dose vial in the United States.

- Power Grid Corporation of India posted consolidated net sales at Rs 11,475.95 crore in September 2025 up 1.76% from Rs. 11,277.76 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 3,566.08 crore in September 2025 down 5.98% from Rs. 3,793.02 crore in September 2024.
- **Titan Company** posted consolidated net sales at Rs 18,725.00 crore in September 2025 up 28.84% from Rs. 14,534.00 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 1,120.00 crore in September 2025 up 59.09% from Rs. 704.00 crore in September 2024.

- Jindal Steel posted consolidated net sales at Rs 12,108.60 crore in September 2025 up 5.26% from Rs. 11,503.98 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 920.67 crore in September 2025 up 2.94% from Rs. 894.35 crore in September 2024.
- **Ajanta Pharma** posted consolidated net sales at Rs 1,353.73 crore in September 2025 up 14.08% from Rs. 1,186.64 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 260.19 crore in September 2025 up 20.19% from Rs. 216.48 crore in September 2024.
- Wockhardt posted consolidated net sales at Rs 782.00 crore in September 2025 down 3.34% from Rs. 809.00 crore in September 2024. Net profit at Rs. 78.00 crore in September 2025 up 454.55% from Rs. 22.00 crore in September 2024.

- U.S. S&P Global US Manufacturing PMI rose to 52.5 in October 2025, up from 52.0 in September.
- U.S. ISM Manufacturing PMI fell to 48.7 in October 2025 from 49.1 in September.
- The Reserve Bank of Australia kept its cash rate unchanged at 3.6% during its November 2025 meeting.
- Japan S&P Global Manufacturing PMI was revised slightly lower to 48.2 in October 2025, down from 48.5 in September.

Economic News

- Crude Oil traded at US\$ 60.59/bbl (IST 17:00).
- INR strengthened to Rs. 88.67 from Rs. 88.79 against each US\$ resulting in daily change of 0.14%.
- India and New Zealand have commenced their fourth round of Free Trade Agreement negotiations in Auckland, focusing on trade in goods and services, and rules of origin. Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal is set to meet his New Zealand counterpart this week to review the ongoing progress. Both nations aim to resolve outstanding issues for an early conclusion of the FTA.
- India and the European Union are holding talks to finalize a free trade agreement. Discussions focus on trade in goods, services, and other key areas. European negotiators are in Delhi for these important discussions. Both sides aim for a balanced and equitable framework. This engagement reaffirms a commitment to a comprehensive trade deal.
- India is set to expedite approvals for importing goods from China and other nations, including electronics and steel, signaling a thaw in relations. This move aims to boost local supply and meet surging consumer demand, especially after recent GST cuts. The government is re-evaluating mandatory certifications for overseas plants to ease supply chain disruptions and support domestic industries facing stockouts.
- Central banks globally ramped up gold purchases in the third quarter of this calendar year, acquiring a net 220 tonnes of the yellow metal, or a 28% increase from the previous quarter, showed the World Gold Council's (WGC) latest Gold Demand Trends Q3 2025.
- Rice prices have dropped considerably after the festive season. This is due to a larger kharif crop harvest this year.
 Common non-basmati rice prices are down, and specialty varieties like Gobindobhog have seen a sharp fall. Basmati prices have also decreased. Exporters are exploring new markets like Japan and Indonesia. Ample supply is expected to keep prices stable for months.
- India's Russian oil imports saw a slight increase in October. However, these shipments are set to decrease starting November. This shift follows new US sanctions targeting major Russian oil producers. Indian refiners are pausing new orders and seeking alternative supplies. Some companies have already stopped Russian oil purchases.



• India's urea imports surged to 58.62 lakh tonnes between April and October this year, more than doubling from the previous year to meet rising domestic demand. The government ensured adequate fertilizer supply for the kharif season, with availability exceeding projected requirements and sales reaching 193.20 lakh tonnes.
